The route pictured is *Calzo de Guagua (7a)*, not *Ahora y Siempre*.

Page 82

The route pictured is on the right wall, not *Maybe*, which is on the left.

Page 83

Don Cojete de la Mancha (8a) is a left hand variation start to *Amigos en el Tope, Ahora y Siempre (7c)*. It is not a separate route as shown on the topo.

Maybe has 12 bolts.

Page 119

Cubanitos en la Red is more like 6b+ than 6c.

Page 120

Chimeneando (6b+) does not have an independent start. It shares the opening moves with *La Playa* – they split around the 2nd bolt.

La Playa is more like 6c+ than 7a.

Page 126

Mujer, Peligro y Placer is more like 6b than 6b+. It has 8 bolts.

Cuando los Angeles Lloran (7a) is sharp, cruxy and loose in places. The star rating should be reduced to 2 stars.

Page 142

There is a new, independent route left of *Socialismo o Muerte*:

*El Cubano de Regresa (6a – 9 bolts) **** A slabby start leads to good holds on the orange rock above the break.

Page 153

Najita has a high first bolt. Either stick clip or use friend #1 or #2.

Page 184

The Chin Chin wall is visible on the left side of the photograph (page 185). From left to right, the routes should be:

Chin Chin (7b) ****

Huracan (8a) It has its own lower-off. It does not finish on the adjacent route.
